

Double Vision Darts Doubles League
Spring 2020 Session
Fact Sheet

What is it?

- A long-format, DigitalSteel Doubles League
- Created to provide both a competitive and short night of dart play
- ADO Member League, powered by Dart Connect
 - One tablet per team (2 per match) is required
- Limited to the **first 8 teams** to register in each division
 - Open to all dart players, 21 years of age or older

When and Where?

- The Mirage Sports Bar
- Open Division - Mondays, 7pm - (to start on Feb 24)
- Progression Division* - Wednesdays, 7pm (to start on Feb 19)
- Session sign up deadline – **February 12, 2020**
 - Limited to the **first 8 teams** to register in each division

***What is the Progression Division?**

- A new division introduced to help keep weekly competition more evenly matched, in which participating teams/players will have a maximum average.
 - The Open Division remains open to all players, regardless of average
- Maximum Team DC Average Rating is 80
 - Maximum individual player rating is 90
 - Player rating = '01 DCA * Ckt DCA
 - Team DC Average Rating = Average of team members' Player Rating
- Players who choose to register their teams to play in the Progression division must first participate in the Progression singles tournament, to determine eligibility.
 - **February 9th**
 - \$10/player – Mirage adding \$5/player.
 - Singles, round-robin format, managed by DartConnect DigitalSteel
 - Players need to bring their own tablets
 - 100% payout
 - Player rating will be calculated from player stats generated from this tournament
- This division is a newly introduced experiment; the maximum ratings, determination of ratings, player placement, and the format may be adjusted for current and future sessions. The administrator has the responsibility to use best judgment to make any necessary adjustments to serve the purpose of the league and the best interest of the players.

What are the Fees?

- \$10/player DPOW membership fee (annual, ends on Dec 31)
- \$50 per team with no alternate, \$60 per team with one alternate, per session
 - One additional alternate allowed, if necessary – fee \$10
 - *Alternates for progression division max DCA rating of 90
- Bar Fee - \$10/player, per session

What is the Format?

- Designed for 2-person play.
 - Only two players can play per night

- Starting the game – One time cork, then alternating start
- Open Division
 - One 7-leg singles segment - 501/501/cricket/cricket /starter calls remaining legs
 - One 7-leg doubles segment – 501/501/cricket/cricket/starter calls remaining legs
 - One 7-leg singles segment (switch opponents) - 501/501/cricket/cricket /starter calls remaining legs
- Progression Division
 - One 5-leg singles segment - 501/501/cricket/cricket /starter calls remaining leg
 - One 5-leg doubles segment – 501/501/cricket/cricket /starter calls remaining leg
 - One 5-leg singles segment (switch opponents) - 501/501/cricket/cricket /starter calls remaining leg

Length of session?

- Will depend on number of teams; Teams will play everyone twice
- Playoffs possible, if there is more than one group in a division
 - Same games, but best of 11 legs

Rules of play?

- ADO rules apply to games played, equipment, and conduct
- If a postponement becomes necessary, please contact opposing team to request, then inform Cindy

End of Session?

- 100% Cash payout from Team Fees
 - Top 50% of teams (by winning percentage) in each division, are paid
- Award Party at the Mirage, date TBD
